Efforts have been made to increase the profile of the list and the group will continue to work with social media staff from OLA in order to increase the online profile of the list. The committee currently needs a new chair. The workshop held at the end of May was attended by 160 attendees and focused on evaluation with speakers Bill Irwin and Kim Silk. The practical application of concepts will continue to be worked on.
