BEFORE YOU START:

In order to edit the Value of Public Library template postcard, you will need to have a Canva account. It is free. You can create an account here: <https://www.canva.com/>

TO ACCESS THE VALUE OF PUBLIC LIBRARY POSTCARD TEMPLATE:

1. Follow this link: <http://bit.ly/ValueofPLTemplate>
2. Click "Use Template"
3. If you are not logged you will be prompted to enter your information.

It's that easy! You can edit the postcard directly on Canva with information about YOUR public library.

TO DOWNLOAD YOUR DESIGN:

Once you're happy with the result, download your designs in a range of file types, such as PDF, PNG, JPEG, and more.

1. Click the downward facing arrow on the top right of the toolbar.
2. Select **Download**.
3. Click the dropdown to [choose a file type](#).
4. If your design has multiple pages, select the pages you want to download from the dropdown, and click **Done**.
5. Click **Download** to finish.

The design will be saved to your device's assigned download folder.
