TORONTO, ON (July 7, 2022): Commitment to community development, architectural & technological innovation, and creative advancements that emphasize local connections are important aspects that are embodied by the recipients of the 2022 Ontario Library Association (OLA) New Library Building Award. The award presentation will be made at the OLA Annual Institute on the Library as Place event, held from July 7-8, 2022, in Toronto, Ontario. This year's theme is "Libraries that Work."

The OLA New Library Building Award is for projects that were completed and in-use within July 2019 to July 2022. The award aims to encourage and showcase excellence in the design of new libraries located in Ontario.

They are a space for gathering, learning, and collaboration and great library design is critical to these experiences," said Shelagh Paterson, Executive Director of OLA. Richmond Hill Public Library - Oak Ridges Branch

From the jury: "The exterior appearance of the Oak Ridges Branch presents the strength of a community facility. The primary materials of the building, timber structure and masonry cladding are used to delineate the major organization of the interior spaces. The transparent timber framework highlights the social spaces, while the stone block contains the quieter area of the

library. The materials, millwork and furniture are used to break down to the scale of the large building to create spaces comfortable for the user. This branch will attract users through its bold design and will welcome them back to its comfortable spaces." - Eric Riddell, Shoalts and Zaback Architects Ltd.
