- Some highlights:
  - OCULA Spring Conference 2022 exceeded revenues!
  - Net income of \$27,743 (88% increase from previous year)
  - OCULA Council budget incurred no fees. All meetings remained virtual, so no expenditures
  - 5-year trend re: conference/events: increase in # of attendees (in-person conference were limited by space), huge increase with virtual conference 2018 (in-person) = 59 attendees vs. 2022 (virtual) = 222 attendees

- This year's working group projects included:
  - Creating a dedicated <u>OCULA EDI Advocacy Group webpage</u>, for members to keep up to date with the group's past, present and future activities, and join if they are interested
  - Organizing an open meeting for all to participate in on Tuesday, March 7 from 2:00pm - 3:30pm
    - Topic of discussion will be Women and Leadership in Libraries, which coincides with International Women's Day the following day, on March 8
